



Food Supply Chain Advisory Group

Scope

Version **v2024-08-27**

Purpose

To convene and represent actors from across the food supply chain that will help to shape, co-design and implement a **Trust Framework solution** that is representative of all stakeholders in the industry, including: producers, processors, distributors, retailers, consumers, regulatory bodies, research bodies, trade bodies and environmental groups.

The Digital Supply Chain Hub (DSCH) has identified a need to develop a data governance framework to build trust and protect the interests of members when sharing data. The framework will contribute to DSCH's goal of transforming UK manufacturing through digitally-empowered supply chains that are more **efficient, resilient and sustainable**.

Outcome

The outcome of the programme will be a consensus governance mechanism and an MVP implementation to establish a data governance framework for a priority use case.

Frequency of meetings

The Advisory Group will meet twice, with one meeting in September and one in November 2024. Meetings last 1.5 hours.

The Advisory Group will:

- Represent perspectives, needs and challenges from across the industry
- Help to define and prioritise use cases to focus on
- Connect with other stakeholders within your industry
- Share insights, learn from others and find solutions to shared problems
- Help to shape a Trust Framework solution
